Update by chuck harris

- Financials- as of end of September \$22,417.59 in the bank, \$16,000 deposit not reflected
- Last year \$26,000 was in at the same time
- Chuck will give a financial report every 3 months, next one end of November
- Chuck looked back over the last 6 years at the money that was available every month and looked and reported on trends, march is always the month where our account runs low, potentially we need another fundraiser around then, this year in july we had \$127
- Pete petry will start around December 10 and will work through march and into april
- Pete needs a place to live and would be a caretaker if need be if anyone has a place for him please let chuck know
- Discussion on how to keep a j-3 coach year round if anyone on the team would be able to provide employment for a j-3 coach in the off-season it would help out tremendously, we will ask for pete petry's resume to pursue this end and hopefully be able to keep a coach for more than a year or two at a time
- Brief description of team members for this year, it is fluent and will be more set around the first of december
- Expectation is around 70-75 members
- \$10,000 donation is fantastic and so appreciated by the board and the entire team, it is this kind of donation that helps the ski team function as a solid entity
- right now is the time of year where the least amount of money going out so the account seems larger than it will be during the season
- jo's- good news, ussa gives us \$4500 in site fee, on board now local option tax will be \$3040 to the team and this will be spent on the jo's and therefore will decrease what the ski team will spend on the jo's
- volkl/marker will be hopefully be the gold medal sponsor for the jo's
- svst will also be on board, will help with wax tent and tables
- in-idaho is helping sponsor as well, organizing the housing and they will give back 10% of bookings to the team, through bookings done with in-idaho
- they would like to be the official booking agency for the ski team and they will help book lodging at away races for the team 10% of these bookings will be given back to the team
- banquet for the jo's will be at shore lodge and shore lodge will be the race headquarters
- looking for more sponsors for the jo's, if anyone knows of a business who would like to sponsor please talk to a board member or chuck harris

- world cup supply will be donating outside gates for the jo's and we will send them back after jo's this will save the team \$5000
- holes we still have are lunches, need someone to donate lunches, to buy it is \$240/day, if someone wants to be a sponsor and let us know
- van sponsorship will go directly to the pay the van off
- brundage writes us a check for \$2500/year and donates the coaches passes they will be on the van

coffee sale- will use grounds for change again this year, everything will be out in October and the sale will go through the month of November, delivered to the buyers second week in December, prices will be approximately the same as last year, first, second and third places prizes will be awarded again

will discuss the parent survey at the next meeting, it will be the first item on the agenda, action item for next meeting is the agenda

get the corporate sponsorships the board is going to pound the pavement for more, we received one from women's health associates
