Bulk Collection Dates

May 10, 2010 - Aug 9, 2010 - Nov 8, 2010

Up to one cubic yard of bulk will be collected from the curb in front of your home only on the dates listed above. One cubic yard of bulk is about the size of a couch, stove or refrigerator and weighs no more than 1,000 pounds. Bulk items more than one cubic yard or weighing more than 1,000 pounds will not be collected, and the home owner or tenant will be subject to a fine of up to \$10,000.

Fight the Blight Reminder

In an effort to keep our community clean and healthy, the Yorkshire Woods Community Organization reminds you that City of Detroit laws require that this property from the middle of the street to the middle of the alley is properly maintained. Owners and/or tenants are responsible for placing waste properly in the Courville Container, keeping the property free from litter, debris, junk, firewood, brush, weeds, inoperable vehicles, grass over eight inches tall, and anything that obstructs traffic or the sidewalk. Failure to comply with these laws will result in a City of Detroit Blight Violation Warning and Notice which leads to assessments and fines ranging from \$25 - \$10,000 PLUS an administrative fee of \$30.

Therefore, to avoid these blight warnings and notices, fees and fines we highly recommend immediately correcting and resolving the following potential violations on this property:

- Bulk items are placed out more than 24 hours before scheduled pickup. The next scheduled pick bulk pick up is:
- Bulk items exceed more than one cubic yard and/or weighs more than 1,000 pounds.
- Unapproved bulk items. Please note: Approved bulk items are furniture,

We are sending letters out to all the business owners in our community asking them to please keep their property neat and clean. **Please do not patronize any business that's not kept clean. This is the only way to let them know we mean business.**

Yorkshire Woods State Representative Bettie Scott has volunteered to take part in the Motor City Makeover clean up our neighborhood

- mattresses, appliances, bundled branches and twigs no more than four feet in length, carpeting and tires (four or less)
- Yard waste (grass clippings, leaves and twigs) are in Courville container and/or plastic bags. Note: Yard waste will only be picked up in paper yard bags.
- Weeds and grass exceed eight inches tall.
- Plastic garbage bags with household waste and debris on property instead of in Courville Container. Please note: Plastic bags placed out on the curb will not be collected with the weekly pick-up.
- Inoperable vehicle(s).
- Alley way overgrown with grass, weeds and debris.
- Courville Container remains out 24 hours after garbage pickup and /or is improperly stored. Please note: Containers must be stored inside or rear yards. They cannot be stored on the curb, front yard or porch.
- Basketball rim in the street or on the sidewalk.

Yorkshire Woods Contact Cards

Communities with watchful neighbors deter crime. That's a fact. We should constantly be vigilant to make sure that our properties are secure and that we support each other when an emergency arise. Therefore, the Yorkshire Woods Community Organization will provide information contact cards to exchange basic information with trusted neighbors. Trusted Neighbors Should contact each other if the following situations arise:

- An unfamiliar car parked in the drive way when no one is typically at home-vacation
- Away from our homes for an extended time
- See a suspicious person around our property
- Having house sitters
- The burglar alarm goes off
- Have arranged for deliveries

- We have not seen each other for a few days
- Work/school schedules change
- There is a broken window or damage to our property

Together we can defeat criminal activity and create a safe and healthy environment.

Basic information about our household is provided on the reverse of the card. Please put it in an accessible place in your home.

Please come to the monthly meeting to get your Neighbor Contact Cards.

Yorkshire Woods Community: Household by household we can make a difference.
