The **WELCOME TEAM** helps people enjoy a warm and friendly weekend worship experience. Our Greeters, Ushers, Café, Welcome Center and Security Hosts all work to ensure a safe, comfortable and welcoming environment for guests and regular attenders.

Roles include: Usher/Greeter, Welcome Center Host, Security Check-in Team, Medical Response Team, Café Service Team, Special Event Food Service

The **CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEAMS** want the Timbertown (birth-5yrs) and Kidsworld (gr. 1-5) environments to be the best part of every kid's week. Our adult teams hope to see an ever-growing number of children find a place where they feel loved, come to know Christ, and continue to grow through fun and life-changing experiences.

Roles include: Nursery Caregiver, Preschool Classroom Teacher, Elementary Section Coach, Elementary Small Group Leader, Music/Worship Leader (all age groups), Room Organization and Toy Sanitation, Curriculum and Craft Preparation, Audio & Video Tech, Games Host

The **CROSSCURRENT STUDENT MINISTRY TEAM** leads fun, friendly, and biblically-focused environments that help students (grades 6 to 12) learn to live for Jesus every moment of their lives and have a passion to serve Him. As group or event leaders, these adult team members allow God to use them to touch young lives.

Roles include: Small Group Leader, Creative Arts (singing, drama, etc.), Outreach Events Team, Audio & Video Tech, Administrative Assistant

The **ARTS & WORSHIP TEAM** uses their artistic, musical, and technical skills to create weekend worship experiences that encourage, instruct, and inspire people to learn and grow.

Roles include: Worship Singers & Instrumentalists, Drama Team, Sound, Lighting & Media Projection Tech, Video Tech , Stage & Prop Team

The **COMMUNICATION & ADMINISTRATION TEAM** uses their abilities in creative writing, graphic and web design, and interpersonal and organizational skills to provide communications and clerical support.

Roles include: Web Development/Maintenance, Graphic Design, Writing/Proofing, Clerical/Telephone Contact, Organizing/Admin Support

The **CARE & SUPPORT TEAM** helps people who are experiencing difficult challenges in their lives through prayer, home/hospital visits, notes, and meals. Trained volunteer counselors can also provide encouragement and counsel through times of personal crisis.

Roles include: E-mail Prayer Team , Hope & a Prayer Visitation Team, Loaves & Fishes Meal Team, Volunteer Counseling Team

The **FACILITY & TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT TEAM** uses their specialized skills to maintain quality facilities, as well as efficient computer and IT equipment for use in ministry by our people and staff.

Roles include: Sunday Custodial, Sidewalk Snow Removal on Sundays, Interior Decorating, Space Utilization/Control, Computer/Telephone Wiring, Computer & Software Support, Maintenance (electrical, plumbing, carpentry, roofing/siding), General Construction, Landscape Maintenance
