Kalia graduated from the University of Wisconsin, La Crosse with both her Bachelors and Masters degrees in school and community health education. Kalia is an active member of the LWML. What she loves to do the most is serve the Lord by supporting the ministry with human care projects.

Gaozong is thirteen years old and will finished the 8th grade this year. She prays and reads the scripture with her parents every night before she goes to bed.

Mercy will be two years old in August and is a happy little boy who loves to play kick ball and says his prayer before eating and sleeping.
