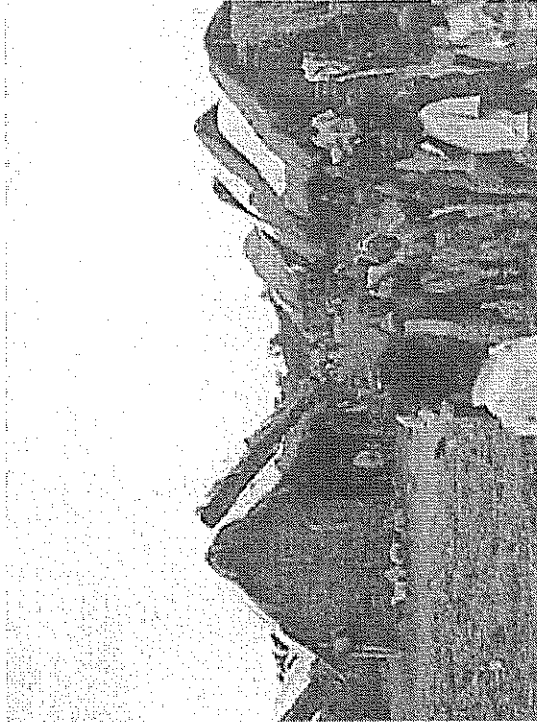


# Official Adoption Agreement For the

Since the National church in Guinea began, LCMS/WM has helped to roof these buildings by providing a tarpaulin for preaching points.

This is a huge encouragement for the people. They have something that would normally be out of their reach. Prices fluctuate drastically, but normally it costs about \$125.00 to put a tarpaulin over a thatch roof that keeps out the rain during rainy season.
