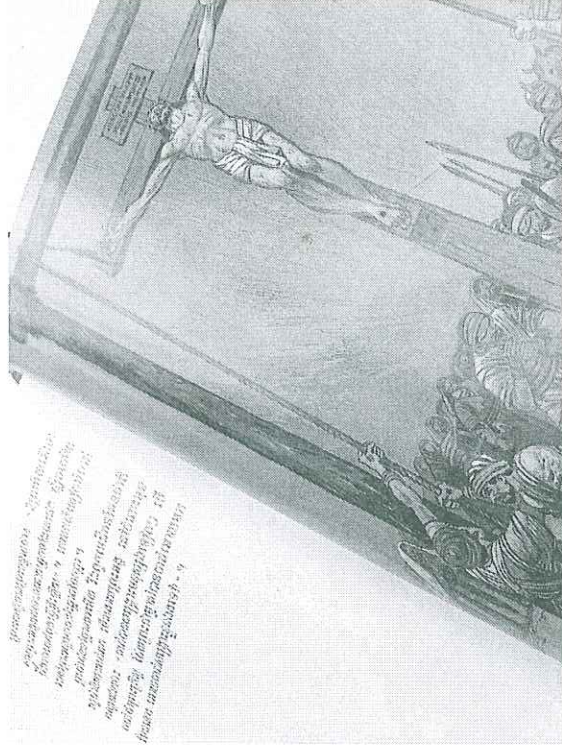


Official Adoption Agreement For the
