#### \*\*\*\*Committee Election\*\*\*\*

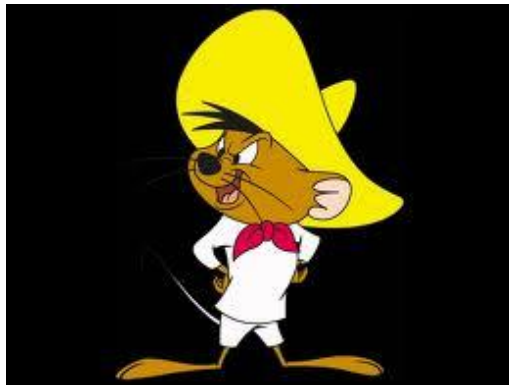
