And thanks again to Ron Hopkins for the use of his trailer.

This was our fourth trip to Helena. Early plans are for us to return next year. (We always remain open to whatever directions God might lead us.) Whether it is in Helena or somewhere else, plan to go with us next year. We will be announcing dates in early 2011.

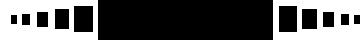
