International Visitors Council

Since last fall, St. John's has been honored by some wonderful foreign visitors who have joined with us to learn about volunteerism, religious pluralism and service to the homeless in the US. They have even served the luncheon meal!

These groups have been facilitated by the International Visitors Council (IVC) of Philadelphia. The IVC is the region's leading international organization for sponsoring citizen diplomacy. Nancy Gilboay, President of the IVC, contacted St. John's last year to explore whether some of her foreign groups could visit and participate in the St. John's program.



To date five groups have been hosted. These include journalists, educators and Muslim clergy from Pakistan, India, Russia, Uzbekistan, Tunisia to name only a few.
