All 9ft. Table Divisions will play against each other at their 9ft. table ratings on Barbox Tables. All Barbox and 8ft. Table Divisions will play against each other on Barbox tables at their respective ratings. This will give each division maximum opportunity to earn a qualifying spot in the AZ State Masters.
