



“Player Audits”

If you believe that a player on another team or on your own team has a handicap rating that is *either* "too high" or "too low" you should submit an audit to have that player reviewed.

- 1. Fill out the Player Audit information at the bottom of this form. Return it in your weekly packet, fax or e-mail it to your league representative or the league office. We will conduct a local audit first to determine if a more in-depth look from the corporate office in Virginia is required. If they determine the need for a H/C change, they will correct it. Due to time lines and various constraints, it could take two weeks before your audit is processed by corporate.

We are happy to review any player and encourage audits. Our objective is to make the League as fair as possible for everyone.
