

Safety nine ball
(Nine ball with a twist)

Here is the scoring system for this interesting new twist on the old stand-by, nine ball. Ball in hand rules apply.

You play a successful Safety.....	5 points
You make a successful kick from safety.....	7 points
You pocket the object ball from a safety.....	10 points
You pocket any other object ball from a safety.....	1 point
You pocket an object ball (including the nine).....	1 point
If you snooker yourself on a shot and make a successful kick.....	7 points
If you are not successful, (a foul has occurred and opponent has ball in hand) opponent receives.....	5 points
Three consecutive fouls.....	30 points
All other fouls (cue ball off table on break, etc) opponent receives....	5 points
Winner is first to.....	150 points

If you commit a foul, and in doing so balls are either pocketed or knocked off the table, the balls are spotted, in numerical order.

Anytime the nine ball is pocketed the rack is over, rerack and play another rack. Keeping the running score.

This game is designed to make you think safety in nine ball. It will improve your winning percentages in matches.
