

MILE HI BARREL HORSE POINT SYSTEM & AWARDS

- MHBHA operates under a Point System. Since contestants do not have to be a member of Mile Hi to compete in our events, we believe a point system is the fairest method to establish champions. For example, what if all the "money holes" were won by non-members, Mile Hi members are then penalized because they didn't receive money. In fairness, awarding points to Mile Hi members provides opportunity for each event to count and apply toward standings.
- **2011-2012 Awards will be determined based on participation. We will communicate the number of placings for each class as we proceed in the competitive year.**
- One (1) point will be awarded to each Mile Hi member entered at each event.
(ie: 32 entries = 32 pts to Mile Hi members only)
Then, placing points will awarded to Mile Hi members as follows:
50 Points = 1st Place, 40 Points = 2nd Place, 30 Points = 3rd Place, 20 Points = 4th Place and 10 Points = 5th Place.
- Open Points will be awarded to the Top 10 (100/90/80/70/60/50/40/30/20/10).
- If you enter a class and receive a NT, DQ, BP (broken pattern), or TO; you will still receive participation points for the number of entries in that class. For NT's you will receive points based on what your time would've been. In the case of BP/Fall/Etc (where no time is available), you receive the points in the "D" you have the most points accumulated in. If none accumulated, then they will be applied to the slowest D (either 4D or 5D).
- **Turn Outs will be limited to a total of 4. Two (2) in the Winter Series and two (2) in the Summer Series. You may not carry them forward or accumulate them.**
- Series/Year-end Champions will be awarded based on total accumulated points.
- Note: You may end up accumulating points in more than one "D" on the same horse, however, you will finish in the "D" you have the greatest number of points in on that horse. In some cases, this may be out of the award positions/placings.
- You may receive multiple sets of awards on multiple horses, you MAY NOT win multiple awards on the same horse.
- Note: Novice Horse is a 4D on ½ second splits.
50+ will be straight pay
Open 4D is ½ second splits unless 150+ then a 5D on ½ second splits (unless otherwise noted on flyer.
Futurity and Derby Classes will be straight pay unless 11+ entered, then 2D pm ½ second split.
- Points toward Standings Will Not Count Unless Membership Is Paid and you are in good standing, all paperwork is received.

Example of Points:

Scenario #1: Betty Barrel Racer enters the Open 4D with a total of 93 entries. She wins 2nd in the 1D. She earns a total of 133 Pts. (40 Pts for Second Place plus 93 - one for each entry- for a total of 133)

Scenario #2: Cathy Can Chaser enters the Open 4D, finds out her horse is lame and Turns Out. She earns a total of 93 Pts. They would be applied to the "D" she had accumulated the most points in as of the date of the Turn Out. If it's the first barrel race, they would be applied in the 4D. Conversely, this same situation happened but it was half way thru the series and all of her points were in the 1D, she would receive 93 1D Points.

Scenario #3: Tabatha Timer enters the Open 4D and hits a barrel. Her time would've been within the 1D times, she earns a total of 93 pts in the 1D, but no placing points. However, if her time would've been in the 2D but most of her points are in the 1D, she receives 2D points because it is based on the "would've been time".
