

Mile Hi Barrel Horse Association Rules and Policies

(Updated October 2011)

- The New Year for Mile Hi Barrel Horse Association (Mile Hi) will run thru September 30, 2011. However, your membership is good for one year from the date you join.
- You must be a member in good standing of Mile Hi to receive any awards, unless otherwise stated. Absolutely No Exceptions.
- Mile Hi Champions will be determined and awarded based on points--NOT MONEY WON. Additional explanation of the Mile Hi Points System is posted on our web-site www.MileHiBarrelHorse.com. Mile Hi will produce a limited number of double pointed shows. Please watch your flyers and web site closely. We will post those shows which count for double points.
- The Open class will be run on a 4D with ½ second splits unless we receive 151+ entries, then it will be paid on a 5D. Unless otherwise stated. Please refer to specific flyer details for exceptions.
- The Novice Horse will be a 4D; half second splits. Payout will be 40/30/20/10 to the 4D's.
- The Novice Rider will no longer be a 2D format; but rather a straight pay.
- The Novice Youth and Junior is for 12 and under as of October 1, 2011. Novice Youth is based on skill level over age limit.
- You may, and we encourage you to, roll your time from/or to any class.
- Entries close when announced or posted. Listen for entry closure times at the barrel race.
- Exhibitions available based on time slots. They are \$5 ea. We will strictly adhere to start times.
- Post Exhibitions will be run on Saturdays only. The arena will be closed at the conclusion of the barrel race on Sundays for tear down.
- Fees for the Novice Youth/Junior/Novice Senior are \$17 with a \$7 office (unless posted otherwise); the Novice Horse/Novice Rider/50+/Youth/Futurity/Derby are \$37 with a \$17 office; the Open is \$47 (including a \$7 proc fee) unless posted otherwise. See specific event flyers for exceptions.
- No tie outs no portable pens in parking lots at any venue unless otherwise noted on entry flyers.
- For Events held at Douglas County Fairgrounds: Attendees will be charged \$10 refundable cleaning fee when reserving/using a stall. Fee will be refunded upon cleaning of stall(s). One horse per stall per night--NO EXCEPTIONS.
