



## Mile Hi Barrel Horse Association Series/Year End Point System\*\*\*



\*\*\*\*You must be a member of MILE HI to receive Series/Year End Awards\*\*\*\*

- **Mile Hi will operate under a Point System.** Since contestants do not have to be a member of MILE HI to compete in our events, we believe a point system is the fairest method. For example, what if non-members won all the “money holes,” MILE HI members could theoretically be penalized because they didn't receive money, thus no points toward standings. To be fair, awarding points to MILE HI members provides opportunity for each event to count and apply toward series-end or year-end standings
  - **Participation Points:** Are awarded as follows:  
1 point will be awarded to each MILE HI member for each contestant entered in a specific class in addition to your “placing points”  
(ie: 132 entries = 132 pts to MILE HI members only) (If a MILE HI member enters and hits a barrel they will receive points based on their “would've been time” If it's a broken pattern, rider comes off, etc. Those points will be applied in the “D” they have the most points accumulated in.) Absolutely no points will ever be awarded for a deliberate pull up.
  - **Open Placing Points.** In addition to participation points, MILE HI members will receive placing points in the OPEN as follows:

100 Points = 1st Place in each D	50 Points = 6th Place in each D
90 Points = 2nd Place in each D	40 Points = 7 <sup>th</sup> Place in each D
80 Points = 3rd Place in each D	30 Points = 8 <sup>th</sup> Place in each D
70 Points = 4th Place in each D	20 Points = 9 <sup>th</sup> Place in each D
60 Points = 5 <sup>th</sup> Place in each D	10 Points = 10 <sup>th</sup> Place in each D
- We will be awarding placing points thru 10th place in the Open in each D, placing points thru 5<sup>th</sup> place in all other classes. Other Classes will receive 50, 40, 30, 20, 10 pts plus their participation points. Series/Year-end Champions and awards will be presented based on total accumulated points.
- Note:** You may end up accumulating points in more than one “D” on same horse, however your final standing will be in the “D” you have the greatest number of points in (regardless of award placing). In the case of multiple nominated horses, you may receive multiple awards. You must declare and pay for the multiple nominations at time of membership.
- **Turn Outs.** If a member turns out, participation points will be awarded in the “D” they have accumulated the most points in. **Turn outs will be limited to a total of 2 per series. That is, 2 in the Winter Series and 2 in the Summer Series and they can not be carried forward or accumulated. Further, you will not be allowed to turn out double pointed events.**
  - **Classes.**
    - **Novice Horse** is a 4D (half second splits). Horse can not have won more than \$1,000 in cash in their barrel racing career at time of nomination. Once nominated they stay Novice all year. Horses may be nominated a maximum of two years.
    - **Open 4D/5D** (regardless of sanctioning) points will be awarded on a 5D on ½ second splits.  
**Note:** If we have 151 or more entries we will PAY on a 5D ½ second splits.
    - **Novice Rider/Novice Senior/Juniors/50+/Futurity and Derby Classes** will be straight pay unless 11+ entered then 2D, on a ½ second split. Novice Rider: Rider can not have won more than \$2,500 in cash and prizes in barrel racing, once nominated stay Novice Rider all year. Novice Senior is 50+ and have not won any money in barrel racing.

- **Youth 4D:** Will be 18 & Under, ½, ½,full. 18 and under as of October 1, 2009.
- **Juniors.** For those 12 and under as of October 1, 2009.
- **Novice Senior.** For those seniors 50+ who have not won money in barrel racing and enjoying the sport now.
- **50+.** For those 50+.
- **Futurity.** For horses that are 5 and under as of January 1, 2010. Can not be nominated Futurity & Derby.
- **Derby.** For horse that are 7 and under as of January 1, 2010.
- **Awards Programs:**  
To Receive Any Mile Hi Awards You Must Be A Member In Good Standings Of Mile Hi Barrel Horse Association.
- **Competitive Year.**  
October 1, 2009 is the first day of the new competitive year.  
September 30, 2010 is the last day of the competitive year.
