



# Mile Hi Barrel Horse Association

## Rules and Policies



- The new year for Mile Hi Barrel Horse Association will kick off October 1, 2009 and run thru September 30, 2010. However, your membership is good for one year from the date you join.
- You must be a member in good standing of Mile Hi Barrel Horse Association to receive any awards. Absolutely No Exceptions.
- **New This Year:** *Affiliate memberships* and Champions will be based on money won at Affiliate Races.
- Mile Hi Champions will be determined and awarded based on points--NOT MONEY WON. Additional explanation of the Mile Hi Points System is posted on our web-site [www.MileHiBarrelHorse.com](http://www.MileHiBarrelHorse.com). Mile Hi will produce a limited number of double pointed shows. Please watch your flyers and web site closely. We will post those shows which count for double points.
- The Open class will be run on a 4D with ½ second splits unless we receive 151+ entries, then it will be paid on a 5D.
- The Novice Horse will be a 4D for the 2009-2010 year; half second splits. Payout will be 40/30/20/10 =1D/2D/3D/4D pots.
- The Novice Youth class will convert to a Junior (12 & Under as of October 1, 2009) for 2010.
- New this year will be a Novice Senior (50+ and have never won any money barrel racing).
- You may, and we encourage you to, roll your time from the Open to ANY Mile Hi class. Or from any Mile Hi Class to any other Mile Hi Class. **You MAY NOT ROLL TO THE OPEN** when we are sanctioned with BBR. If entered in the Open, you must make your Open run. We understand your desire to limit the number of runs on the horses (especially the young ones). Rolling your time can be a very VIABLE and profitable option--instead of making your horses run multiple times. You simply must declare it at entry time.
- Full Western Attire required for ALL classes, unless otherwise noted at day of race.
- Entries close when announced. Listen for entry closure times at the barrel race.
- Exhibitions available based on time slots. We only sell them one hour out. They are \$5 ea. **We will strictly adhere to start times.**
- Post Exhibitions will be run on Saturdays only. The arena will be closed at the conclusion of the barrel race on Sundays for tear down.
- For Events held at Douglas County Fairgrounds: Stalls available on site. \$20/stall plus \$10 cleaning fee. \$10 refunded when stalls are cleaned. One horse per stall per night--NO EXCEPTIONS. No tie outs no portable pens in parking lots. Of course, these prices subject to change without notice.
- For events held at The Ranch-Larimer County Fairgrounds: Stalls are available on site. \$25/stall per night. To tie outs or pens allowed in parking lots. Of course, these prices are subject to change without notice.
