Riding Sessions:

20 minute riding/working sessions available Saturday/Sunday/Monday mornings (\$10/horse) limit 10 horses per session:

Session I 8:00 - 8:20 am Session II 8:20-8:40 am Session III 8:40-9:00 am EXHIBITIONS: 9:00 am – 10:30 am each day.

To reserve a slot in a riding session or purchase an exhibition in the FIRST HALF HOUR ONLY (9:00 – 9:30), you must call Monday Evening May 24th, 2010 from 7-9pm 720.530.4159. All other exhibitions will be sold ONLY ON-SITE.

NOTE: You may only pre-purchase or reserve riding sessions and exhibitions between 9:00 -9:30 am. All other exhibitions sold on-site.

- > You do **NOT** need to be a member of any association to enter any of our classes. On-Site entries are CASH ONLY and will go to bottom of draw. Mile Hi members may write checks—**non-members = cash only**. Average calculation will be figured on your 2 run average (Fastest time from Sat/Sun plus your Monday time) Thus average is Monday + your Saturday or Sunday Time (whichever is faster).
- > **You can avoid late fees by simply PRE-ENTERING. Entries must be postmarked or you can email by SATURDAY MAY 15, 2010.** Email entries received after Midnight May 15th will be considered late entries and subject to late fees. Late entries will go to bottom of pre-entry draw. Draws will be posted at www.MileHiBarrelHorse.com you may on-site beginning 5/28/2010 **CASH ONLY late fee applies. Entries for the entire weekend will close 2 pm on Sunday May 30th, 2010--you must get your entry in for Monday on Sunday prior to 2 pm on Sunday. ABSOLUTELY NO ENTRIES TAKEN AFTER 2 PM Sunday!**
- > A **ONE TIME** late fee of \$20 on entries received after May 15th and all on-site entries. Pay late fee only once, regardless of number of entries or horses being entered. **Just a one-time fee.** But, it's avoidable....enter early.
- > **One time processing fee of \$20 per person (except Nov Youth/Juniors). All classes pay a processing fee==ALL CLASSES receive awards.**
- > Roll your time option available. Must declare at time of entering. **NOTE: THOSE ENTERED IN THE SLOT RACE AND SUNDAYS BARREL RACE MAY ROLL THEIR TIME FROM YOUR RESPECTIVE SUNDAY ENTRY TO THE SLOT RACE.**
- > Vet releases must be received in writing no later than Monday, May 21ST. **No refunds after May 21st.** Substitutions allowed.
- > On-Site stalls available. Those reserving stalls via pre-entry will be guaranteed a stall. Requests will be handled on a first come first served basis. Stalls are \$20/night. One horse per stall. Bring your own shavings---none available on site. You may tie out or build portable pens on site.
- > RV hookups available on site \$20/night – limited number First Enter/First Served. Those reserving RVs via pre-entry will be served first. You may not reserve RV only's. We will only assign RV's to those who also send in pre-entries.
- > In case of inclement weather we have the indoor reserved as well.
- > Western Dress code required in all classes. (Hat or helmet, long sleeve shirt, and boots or heels down.)
- > **Mile Hi Barrel Horse reserves the right to deny entry at its discretion.**
