- You do **NOT** need to be a member of any association to enter any of our classes. On-Site entries are CASH ONLY and will go to bottom of draw. Mile Hi members may write checks—**non-members = cash only.**
- Youth 4D and Open are WPRAs Approved. Please make sure you provide your number.
- Full Western Attire required both days of the event.
- Futurity and Derby classes run both days since it is a double point show.
- Roll your time option available. Must declare at time of entering. Must Roll From the Open to any Other Class(es). You must run in Open. Can roll between other classes as well.
- 75% Payback in Open; all other classes' utilized standard Mile Hi payouts
- On-Site stalls available. Those reserving stalls via pre-entry will be guaranteed a stall. Requests will be handled on a first come first served basis. Stalls are \$20/night. One horse per stall. Bring your own shavings---none available on site. You may tie to trailers and/or build portable pens.
