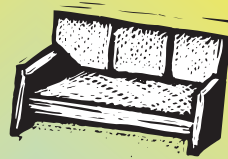
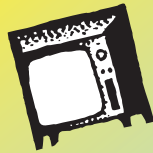


Second Chances

A Message from Newark Mayor Sharpe James

Dear Friend,

People are always disposing of clothing they've outgrown, furniture that's become worn and toys the kids no longer play with. But as long as these items are still usable, the landfill is the last place we should want to put them. After all, our planet is facing an environmental crisis because our throwaway society encourages short-term use and disposal of products. As a result, we're consuming vast amounts of natural resources and running out of places to put our trash.

You have probably heard the expression, "one person's trash is another person's gold." We feel we can reduce waste by getting usable items that one person might throw away into the hands of those who would consider these items valuable resources. That's why we created *Second Chances: The Planet Newark Guide to Donating Unwanted Goods*. This booklet is designed to provide residents and businesses in Newark with information on local organizations that accept donations of used household and office items.

Index of Goods Accepted for Donation

1 Whenever you have clean and usable clothing, appliances, furniture or other household items you no longer need, don't throw them away. Set them aside for donation to an organization working for the Newark community.

2 Use the alphabetical Index of Goods accepted for Donation to find the item(s) you wish to donate.

3 Under each entry is a listing of the organizations that accept that item for donation.

4 Look up the page number for a description of that organization and how to make arrangements for your donation.
