Available funds: **\$36,500**

**OPTION #2** (Based on 60% funding of our Hawaii grant total for 2007)  
Available funds: **\$87,600**

St. Matthew's Lutheran Mission (final year) -	\$8,000
Waikoloa Lutheran Mission (1 <sup>st</sup> year) -	\$38,000

**COMMENTS/EXPLANATIONS**

In option #1, it was decided that Ungil Chais should receive as much of its 2007 grant as possible since it is a multi-year grant (top priority), is healthy and growing and the pastor and his family of five receive only \$24,000 in annual salary and to take any more away would put them in serious financial hardship.

We also have an unbreakable commitment to John Bombaro at St. Matthew's to reimburse his moving expenses that he never has recouped from moving to Kauai. St. Matthew's was never able to cover those expenses so the Big MAC has directed us cover it in a grant. \$8000 is what is left to be reimbursed that John covered on his own. The CNH District has a contingency fund to cover his family's move back to the mainland that is separate from our grant funding.

In option #2, Ungil Chais was fully funded for reasons stated above. Lutheran Campus Ministry receives 60% of its grant request and Waikoloa Mission receives 63%. Under the present circumstances, we feel these options provide the most impact with the best stewardship. We all pray that we receive 60% funding as anything less will hinder the mission work here in the islands to a large degree.
