## II. DOCTRINES THAT I HAVE DISCUSSED.

- A. The doctrine of the Godhead – the Bible teaches that the one God is made up of three distinct personalities. JN 17:3; EP 4:4-6; MK 12:29; 1 CO 8:6; PH 2:6; JN 1:1-3, 14; 8:17; CO 2:9; Acts 17:29; GE 1:2, 26; MT 3:13-17; 28:19.
- B. The doctrine of the polytheism – plurality of gods – the Bible teaches that the OT and NT rejected polytheism. God’s people are commanded to recognize and worship only the one, true God – GE 35:1-7; EX 20:1-6; DT 4:39; 5:7-8; JS 24:23; RO 1:19-25; 1 CO 8:4-6.
- C. The doctrine that God was once a man – the Bible teaches that there is no change in God – NU 23:19; PS 102:27; IS 43:10-11; 44:6; 45:21-22; JA 1:17.
- D. The doctrine that God is flesh and bone – the physical description of God in the Bible is call “anthropomorphism.” This word is a figure of speech in which an act or attribute of God is described in terms of human activity or qualities, for example, the “hand” of God – PS 119:73. If verses like EX 33:11 teach that God has a physical body, does PS 91:4 teach that God has wings? IS 40:12-26 says that God cannot be likened to anyone or anything on earth. IS 31:3 teaches that God is Spirit, as does JN 4:24. JN 1:18 says no one has ever seen God.
- E. The doctrine that Christ will return to the earth someday at the Battle of Armageddon, the righteous will be resurrected, the wicked will be judged, the millennium will be begin, Satan will be released at the end of the millennium, the final judgment, earth is renewed and men will dwell upon the earth. The Bible teaches us that Jesus is coming! When? MT 24:36; MK 13:32. The Kingdom has already been established – IS 2; DA 2; Acts 2. The Kingdom will be delivered to the Father – 1 CO 15:24. The judgment scene is in MT 25:1-46.
