

PERSONAL TESTIMONY

Born to a staunch Roman Catholic family, I started to hear the gospel and join youth bible studies while in college in 1978. But my heart was real cold and passive up to the time I finished my 5-year engineering course. While working as a young engineer, I experienced one deep emotional crisis which brought me to attend a public evangelistic campaign and received Christ to save me on October 26, 1985. I followed the water baptism and was given a bible and told to read it myself to grow. I was never invited to go to their church. So, I just personally read my whole bible from Genesis to Revelation without any guidance. Later on, I was drawn back to Roman Catholicism and to the world.

After getting a stable job, I decided to get married to have my own family at the same time start a small business in the hope of having a complete, joyful and abundant life. However, my business venture crashed and suffered a big loss. While struggling and suffering the mess, a bible woman shared the gospel to me and asked me to receive Christ which I did again on September 24, 1993. This time I was invited to church, baptized and lovingly nurtured by a Baptist Pastor who helped me to grow in the Word of God.

While serving as Deacon in Grace Baptist Church in Baybay, Leyte, Philippines, God burdened me to full-time ministry in 1996 through Isa.6:8. But because my wife was not ready to go yet, it took another six more years of praying and waiting for her before she yielded to the calling. Then, we were sent by the church for full-time ministry in April 2002 as a Foreign Missionary to Cambodia together with my two kids.

Working in Cambodia Foreign Missions from May 2002 to October 2010, God enabled me to finish my formal bible school training at the Baptist Bible College through my new sending church, Bethany Baptist Church, Makati City, Philippines, under Pastor Gerardo Nable. In Cambodia, God's grace also allowed me to open two mission churches and blessed me with one Khmer disciple presently on bible school training in the Philippines.

Due to my strong burden to keep my children close to us in the ministry, God through my sending church granted my transfer of mission field to Singapore on November 10, 2010, where my younger daughter could continue her college education and the older one could be with us, with close parental guidance serving the Lord together as one whole family.
