2 Corinthians 1:5-7	Thank you Lord for your compassion (mercy) when I stumble. Help me to bless you for your mercy instead of blaming you for my stumbling.
2 Corinthians 1:5-7	Thank you Lord for your comfort in my suffering. Let me draw close to you in my sufferings and not allow my suffering to isolate myself from you or others. Don't let my suffering be a stumbling block in declaring my praise and faith in you or a stumbling block to those around me that the devil will use to destroy their faith.
1 Peter 2:8-10	Lord, thank you for calling me out of darkness into the light through Jesus. Let me build on him and not stumble over him. Lord, I pray you give me opportunities to share the gospel story of Jesus as the rock to build on with those around me who are rejecting him.
Malachi 2:8	Lord, let me daily be in your word to study for myself. Let the Holy Spirit lead me into all truth and remove any false teachings that would be a stumbling block to my spiritual growth.
Matthew 18:6	Lord, thank you for children. Let me accept the challenge to point them to you and not be a stumbling block in my words, attitudes, or behaviors.
Job 4:4	Lord, I take heart that you support me when I stumble. Thank you for giving me strength when I falter.
Psalms 119:105	Lord, make me aware of the things that can cause me to stumble by shining the light of your word on my path.
Psalms 37:24	Lord thank you for your steady hand that holds me up and keeps me from falling when I stumble.

Significant Statements

You often stumble in the areas where God wants to provide mercy and comfort.

You often get tripped up over seemingly little things that you're not paying attention to, are not aware of, or are put there by others.

Turn your stumbling stones into building blocks.

Determine you will be a support to children and not their stumbling block.

Turn your stumbling blocks into building blocks through awareness, knowledge, and an attitude of overcoming.

God wants to turn your mess into a message, your test into a testimony, and your trial into a triumph.
