Source Defined

Merriam Webster: (noun) "someone or something that provides what is wanted or needed"

The Culture of Orphan

An orphan, or a person that has the mindset of an orphan, almost always believes that he must secure his own provision, protection and place

Gen 3:1-10

- They clothed themselves
- They hid
- · They knew that they were naked

Clothed themselves – provision

Hid themselves – protection

They knew they were naked - place

The Culture of Son

Joh 14:18 "I will not leave you comfortless (as an orphan): I will come to you."

g3737. ὀρφανός orphanos; of uncertain affinity; bereaved ("orphan"), i.e. parentless: — comfortless, fatherless. AV (2) - comfortless 1, fatherless 1; bereft (of a father, of parents) of those bereft of a teacher, guide, guardian; orphaned

Son Culture – continually informs us that God (our Father) is our source!!

The result is Son

The result is Heir

The result is Equal heir

Orphan Culture - continually informs us that we are (self is) our source

Until a believer sees himself as son he will never see himself as an heir!!

We see, in ourselves and in others, an incredible tension between the mindset of an orphan and the mindset of a son.

NOTE: As one experiences greater maturity, we observe that the conflict and competition between the mindset of an orphan gives way to a more settled place of spiritual rest resulting from an abiding mindset of a son.

Living Out of the Source of God

Joh 5:30 Zondervan Classic Amplified Bible "I am able to do nothing from Myself [independently, of My own accord—but only as I am taught by God and as I get His orders]. Even as I hear, I judge [I decide as I am bidden to decide. As the voice comes to Me, so I give a decision], and My judgment is right (just, righteous), because I do not seek or consult My own will [I have no desire to do what is pleasing to Myself, My own aim, My own purpose] but only the will and pleasure of the Father Who sent Me"

Rejected or Accepted?

Once enemies --- Saved by His death: Rom 5:10

Once reconciled --- Saved by His life: Rom 5:10

We were saved by His death: reconciled while enemies

We are continually being saved by His life: because we have received the resurrected Christ!!

Saved By His Life -- Not Mine or Yours -- His!

His Life is Transcendent

His Life is Resurrection

His Life has Overcome and is Overcoming

As a *son* of your Father, you are accepted in the One who is constantly being loved!! (see Eph 1:6) ((*son* is a reference to spirit. Some are allowing themselves to get hung up on our humanity and insist that the reference must be one associated with gender. But God is a spirit and <u>you</u> are a spirit. Do not allow yourself to major on the minor point here and miss the larger truth.))

The Divine Life

Life is a PERSON!
