Influential Sacramento-area pastor Glen Cole dies

The Rev. Glen Cole, one of the region's most influential pastors, died this morning. He was

Cole was found in his car in the parking lot of Trinity Life Church in Sacramento where he was senior pastor. Church workers, concerned that he had not walked into the office, found him unresponsive.

"He drove to work, undid his <u>seat belt</u> and passed," said his son, the Rev. Rick Cole. "This is a great shock for us, a big loss for us and for the community."

He said his father was not known to have health problems.




