## United Food & Commercial Workers 588 Northern California General Nomination of Officers

The offices of President, Secretary-Treasurer, Recorder and Vice Presidents 1 through 19, inclusive are open for nomination for election to three-year terms of office.

This shall serve as official notice to the active membership of UFCW 588 that nomination petitions for any of the above offices must be submitted in person, by U.S. mail or other carrier no later than 5:00 p.m. July 25, 1997, at the main office of UFCW 588, 2200 Professional Drive, Roseville, CA 95661, to the attention of Lee Berns, General Chairperson.

Each page of the petition must contain the name of the active member being nominated, the specific office for which that member is being nominated, and valid, verifiable original signatures. No less than 217 active members in support of said nomination are required.





Dear Brother Nordby:

You have submitted, to the undersigned, petitions nominating you to run for the office of President of UFCW 588-Northern California. Valid signatures of 217 active members of UFCW 588 are required for a member to be nominated to run for an elected office. While your petitions contain the signatures of 285 persons, we could not count 168 of the signatures as valid signatures to support your nomination because those persons were either not active members or have presented to me written notice of their rescision of their signatures in support of your nomination prior to your submission of your nominating petitions.

You were previously provided copies of each of the rescision notices. We utilized the same procedures to verify the rescision letters as we did for the nomination petitions. In addition, we compared the signatures on the rescision letters to the signatures on the nomination petitions.

As a result of this process, we have been able to determine that you have presented 117 valid signatures in support of your nomination to run for President of UFCW 588-Northern California. You have failed to present a timely petition with sufficient valid signatures, i.e. 217, to support your nomination. Therefore, you have not satisfied the requirements to be a nominee for the office of President of UFCW 588-Northern California.
