Highlights include 2 bonuses and 1 wage increase, an increase in the minimum guarantee of hours, job security protections and continued medical benefits with no weekly premium for current employees at this time. An overwhelming rejection vote on the Employer's previous offer resulted in Food 4 Less making significant improvements to their final offer.

Los Angeles City Council Votes "Yes" On Superstores Ordinance to Give Neighborhoods a Strong Voice in

Accepting or Rejecting New Superstores like Wal-Mart; Final City Council Vote Scheduled for Wednesday

Los Angeles (August 10, 2004) On August 10, 2004, the Los Angeles City Council overwhelmingly voted "yes" on the Los Angeles Superstores Ordinance, a landmark law that will enable the City of Los Angeles to evaluate the economic impacts of proposed superstores, giving residents and officials more information and a greater voice in the planning process. Upon formal approval, the ordinance is expected to serve as a model for other cities in California and across the country.

The threat of Wal-Mart's entry into the California supermarket business was a driving force behind supermarket giants' Vons/Pavilions (Safeway), Ralphs (Kroger), and Albertsons attempt to slash grocery


