Programs

Worship is celebrated in both traditional and contemporary ways at 9:30 a.m. each Sunday. Holy Communion is served to all the first Sunday of the month.

Childcare by experienced adults is provided each Sunday.

Sunday School for children meets weekly following the special children’s time in worship. A dedicated team of teachers and helpers assure that children have a positive learning experience.

Youth Ministries meet regularly on our church campus. Activities include study and discussion of relevant issues confronting young Christians, small group experiences, outings and youth camp.

Small Groups meet at various times for Bible study, exploring Christianity, fellowship and a source of support.

Music Ministry opportunities are available for musicians and vocalists to develop their talents and participate in ensembles and choral groups.

Alpha Course introduces the basics of the Christian faith.

Band of Sisters is a program for women to meet to enrich their spiritual growth and experience community with other women.

Men’s Ministry is a program for men to meet to enrich their spiritual growth and experience community with other men.

Recovery Ministries, A.A. and other recovery and support groups, such as Grieving a Loss, meet regularly in our facilities.
