Please note this location is not open for Urgent Care services at this time. COVID-19 evaluation and testing is 100% covered by most insurance plans. We apologize, but we will not be testing a patient under 2 years old.

**Voter Information – 2020 Municipal Election!**– The City of Huntsville will hold elections on **August 25, 2020** for Mayor and School Board Members for Districts 1 and 5. Dates to remember are:

- August 10 – Last day to register in order to vote in the General Municipal Election
- **August 20 – Deadline to apply for absentee ballots** for the General Municipal Election
- **August 24 – Last Day to return absentee ballots** for the General Municipal Election
- August 25 - Municipal Election Day – Polls Open 7:00 am to 7:00pm

If you are in need of an absentee ballot application, you may call 256 427 5039 to get one mailed to you. The completed application must have a copy of your driver's licenses and your signature witnessed. The application should be mailed to the address on the application. After this document is returned, an absentee ballot will be mailed to you. The absentee ballot will need a signature witnessed by two people or a Notary Public.
