COVID-19 testing Available at:

- The Fever and Flu Clinic: 120 Governors Drive, SW which is at the intersection of Governors Drive and Franklin Street. Just passed the Starbucks. Open from Monday through Friday 9am-5pm.
- Thrive Alabama will provide drive-up COVID-19 testing to the public from 10 am - 1 pm at 600 St Clair Avenue: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. No physician order is required. If you have insurance, no co-pay is required. Insurance is not required.
- Urgent Medicare, 12287 US Hwy 232/431 N, Meridianville, AL 35759; TeL 256-828-1184. e-registration: is available at www.urgentmedcareonline.com/reg. Offering COVID-19 (coronavirus) drive-thru testing at our Meridianville center from 9am - 6pm Monday through Friday and 9am - 5pm on weekends. We test both patients who have COVID-19 symptoms and those without symptoms who are worried that they may have been exposed. No referrals are needed. Results typically take 3-5 days. Please note this location is not open for Urgent Care services at this time. Please visit our Huntsville Location for Urgent Care services. COVID-19 evaluation and testing is 100% covered by most insurance plans. We apologize, but we will not be testing a patient under 2 years old.

May is National Stroke Awareness Month: On average, someone in the U.S. has a [stroke](#) every 40 seconds, and every 4 minutes someone dies from one, according to the [National Institutes of Health](#). Stroke is one of the leading causes of death in the U.S. and causes more long-term disabilities than any other disease. The older you are, the more likely you are to have a stroke, as the risk of having a stroke more than doubles each decade after age 55.
