UNION CHAPEL CHRONICLES 1933 - 2022

- Union Chapel was organized on October 4, 1933 in the home of O. D. & Lucy Boone located on Blue Springs Road.
- They selected the name "Union Chapel" due to the "unity" exemplified by the members.
- The first church services were held in a two-room house on Winston Street; moving to Compress Street, Ward Avenue, Lowe Street.
- PASTOR Boone and his sons, Harry and George, began construction of the building for a permanent location located at
 - **530 Gardner Street** where services were held in the basement.
- The church experienced great growth during Pastor Boone's twenty-four years (24) tenure as Pastor.
- Being ever mindful of the need to religiously educate our children, he established a full-time kindergarten with certified Teaching staff.
- **Pastor/Founder O. D. Boone** served Union Chapel faithfully until he was called home to be at rest with the Saviour on **October 9, 1957**.
- **Reverend Riley Townsend served** as Interim Pastor for six months. He departed this life to heavenly reward on **May 31, 1995**.
- Loyace F. and Ester Copeland Lacy accepted the call to serve as the second Pastor of Union Chapel in April 1958.
- He completed the construction of the church sanctuary on Gardner Street that was initiated by Pastor Boone. A new church location had to be found due to the Huntsville Urban Renewal Project.
- On August 3, 1968 ground-breaking ceremony was held on the property purchased from the family of Orange Hayden in "Spragins Hollow"/100 Orange Drive to build a new Sanctuary. The Church Sanctuary was completed one year later with one hundred-eighty-nine members on roll.
- Recorded a live Sunday evening radio broadcast on WEUP radio each week.
- Pastor Lacy saw the vision and need to better serve the community and a new educational
 complex was erected on April 11, 1982. It provided facilities for religious, social and
 recreational activities for members and the sur-rounding community as well as housing a fulltime state licensed day-care center.
- Established Baptist Training Union (BTU), Sunbeam and Red Circle choirs, and Mission groups.
- Pastor Lacy labored in the vineyard for thirty years before his retirement on July 23, 1988 due to failing health.
- Mother Ester Lacy, always the willing servant passed on December 1, 1983. Pastor Lacy went

- to his heavenly reward on March 21, 1992.
- Rev. Gonzer Lee Gist, an Associate Minister for fifteen years was elected to serve in the Interim.
- Many members of the Lacy Family still remain in the Union Chapel fellowship and seek to preserve his contributions and service to it by carrying on his work in the vineyard.
- **O. Wendell and Dora Davis** accepted the call to serve and he was installed as the **third Pastor** of Union Chapel when he preached his acceptance message **on July 2, 1989**. He was officially installed as Pastor on **September 17, 1989**.
- Shortly thereafter in September 1989, Pastor Davis initiated a 7:45 a.m. service and mid-day bible study class in order to serve the growing congregation. He revitalized the bus/van ministry and weekly television/radio broadcasts.
- April 14, 1993, Church acquired one-hundred fifty (150) acres of land on Winchester Road from the family of Frank Ellis Strong, a former slave.
- 1995 Due to tremendous growth, services were moved from the main Sanctuary to the newly expanded Educational Complex (Gym/Multi-purpose room) at the Orange Drive location. Striving to be good stewards of God's blessings, in 1996 the mortgage for the 150 acres of land located on Winchester Road was paid off early.
- The Union Chapel Institute of Biblical Studies was founded by Pastor Davis as a vision to train men and women for the work of the church in **December 1998**.
- On February 17, 2002, Dedicatory Services were held for the new-multi-million dollar edifice
 which housed a new modern sanctuary with state-of-the art audio and visual equipment,
 administrative offices, classrooms, nursery, fellowship hall, commercial kitchen, full basement
 with youth classrooms, bride's room; small chapel, recreational softball field and a covered
 picnic pavilion. The Watch-Care Ministry was initiated.
- March 23, 2003, A Sign Language Ministry was established for the hearing-impaired worshippers and television audience.
- On **September 26, 2004** Dedication of the newly constructed Child Development Center for infants six (6) weeks to four (4) years of age; nourishing the next generation in a caring and safe Christian educational environment.
- More than 250 new members were added to the church family in 2004.
- The dedication of the Family Life Center was held on February 13, 2005. It was a result of
 Pastor Davis' vision to nurture the whole body, mind, and soul; through state-of-the art
 elliptical equipment, indoor walking track; regulation indoor basketball court; classroom space
 for wellness seminars and events; and commercial kitchen.
- May 2, 2005- The Union Chapel Family Life Center officially opened with approximately one hundred members using the recreation facility on a daily basis. The center housed the After School program and also the Summer Camp program
- August 23, 2005—An Afternoon Sunday School class was initiated to accommodate those members who could not attend the 9:30 a.m. Sunday School Classes.
- October 1st- The first Habitat House was built by Union Chapel. The church went an extra mile and provided labor and all financial support.
- November 10th- Musical workshop and concert conducted by Bishop Leonard Scott, creator of "Hymns for the Nation" CD.

- January 1, 2006 Pastor Davis declared the "Year of Deliverance and Restoration.
- On January 18, 2006, we retired the mortgage for Phase#1 Building project (Church Sanctuary).
- February 18, 2006

 Union Chapel Passage Ministry established by celebrating 61 candidates (24 Girls and 37 Boys) entering Phase I during the first Pre-Passage Ceremony.
- On **August 9, 2006**, the Union Chapel Christian Academy opened its 2006-07 academic year with nine teachers and support staff and ninety-five students in grades K-5 through 6th grade. Classes were initially held in the Family Life Center.
- The foundation was laid for the expansion of the Family Life Center to connect to the new Christian Academy facility on March 26, 2007.
- On **February 10, 2008**, the dedication of the New Union Chapel Christian Academy facility with additional space allowed the curriculum to expand to accommodate students through 7th grade.
- 2009 January 12th The Union Chapel Institute of Biblical Studies celebrated its' 10thAnniversary. UCIBS was founded by Pastor O. Wendell Davis in 1998 as a result of a vision in an effort to train men and women for the work of the church. More than 200 graduates have been blessed to receive degrees/certificates from the UCIBS.
- January 12th The Stitch-in-Time Ministry began offering instructional classes in quilting and crocheting. The Coordinators were Mother Betty Craighead and Sis. Flora Ector.
- January 17-21st-The Youth Ministry witnessed the historic Inauguration of our 44th President Barack Obama in Washington, D.C.
- February 7th- The Union Chapel Cancer Support Group held its Kick-Off Session with Special Guest Speaker, Donna Green-Goodman, MPH, author of "Something' To Shout About! This Ministry was established through the vision of Pastor Davis, Cancer Survivor Joyce Hampton and others in an effort to provide support to all those affected by Cancer.
- March –Sis. Linda Earl and Deacon George Prude were commissioned to the Foreign Mission Ministry in West Africa.
- March 18th Union Chapel participated in the Church-Wide Mission Project, "Serving the City as ONE" a day of service for Christians across Madison County.
- April 26th Pastor O. Wendell Davis presented the "Peace, Unity, Honesty & Leadership Achievement Award during the annual banquet of the Harry Ross Promotions event in Atlanta, Ga.
- May 24th Bro. Bakari Jordan delivered his trial sermon; he was supported by many family members and friends.
- July 12-19th The Walter Cade, Jr. Laymen's Southwest Workshop was held in Huntsville at the Von Braun Civic Center. Union Chapel along with First Missionary Baptist Church was the area host churches.
- Since our last Church Anniversary in 2008, **two hundred twenty-seven (227**) new members have been added to the Union Chap- el Family
- 2010 Bible college classes, mid-day and night bible study sessions, Passage, Sunday school, spiritual counseling, leadership workshops, seminars, renewal services, intercessory prayer services, recreational activities, community services, radio and television broadcasts, are just a few of the tools by which Pastor Davis continues to plant new seeds and cultivate the next

generation.
