- I. The First, Seth (Genesis 4:25-5:8)
 - 1. Birth (Genesis 4:25-26): Born after the death of Abel
 - 2. God's gift to replace Abel; firstborn son of Adam and Eve (Genesis 4:25)
 - 3. Life span of Adam and Seth (Genesis 5:3-8)
- II. The Second, Enoch (Genesis 5:18-24)
 - 1. Birth (Genesis 5:18): His father was Jared (Genesis 5:18)
 - 2. There are ten patriarchs from Adam to the flood (Genesis 4:25-5)
 - 3. Life span of Enoch (Genesis 5:23)
- III. The Third, Methuselah (Genesis 5:18-27)
 - 1. Birth (Genesis 5:21-22)
 - 2. The oldest person we find in the Bible, lived longer than anyone (Genesis 5:27)
- IV. The Fourth, Noah (Genesis 5-9)
 - 1. Birth (Genesis 5:28-29)
 - 2. Noah had favor with God, and was called to build the Ark. He and his family wee the only people saved from the flood. Noah and Enoch were the only persons mentioned in the Bible in reference to literally "walking with God." (Genesis 5:24, 6:9)
