- I. Adam's Disobedience (Genesis 3:1-6)
  - 1. Treachery (Genesis 3:1-5)
    - A. Satan casts doubt (Genesis 3:1-3): "Did God really say...?"
    - B. Satan denies God's Word (Genesis 3:4-5): "You won't die!"
    - C. The Tragedy (Genesis 3:6): "Both Adam and Eve did eat..."
- II. Adam's Deceit (Genesis 3:7-8)
  - A. Adam's despair (Genesis 3:9-11): Acknowledges fear and nakedness
  - B. Adam's defense (Genesis 3:12-19): Blames Eve, but Eve blames the serpent
  - C. Adam's discipline (Genesis 3:14-19): God's divine court in Eden
- III. Adam, Eve and Satan's Sentence (Genesis 3:14-19)
  - A. Upon Adam (Genesis 3:17-19): Labor and physical death
  - B. Upon Eve (Genesis 3:16): Pain in childbirth and ruled by husband
  - C. Upon Satan (Genesis 3:14-15): Crawl on the belly, eat dust, and defeated by the woman's offspring, Christ
  - D. Upon Nature (Genesis 3:18): Infested with thorns and thistles
- IV. Adam's Deliverance (Genesis 3:15, 20-21)
  - 1. The Prophecy (Genesis 3:15): Someday a Redeemer will come
  - 2. The Provision (Genesis 3:20-21)
  - 3. The conditions of Adam's dismissal:
    - a. God's grace (Genesis 3:22-23): Removed from the Garden. Why?
    - b. Angelic guards (Genesis 3:24): At the eastern entrance.
