GENESIS OUTLINE 3

"Abel's Testimony" (Genesis 4:1-26)

- I. Abel, the godly son (Genesis 4:1-2, 4)
 - 1. Abel was obedient (vv 1-2, 4)
 - 2. Abel offered an animal sacrifice to God (vv 1-2, 4)
- II. Cain, the godless son (Genesis 4:3-26)
 - 1. The apostate (v. 3: He offers a bloodless offering
 - 2. The angered (vv 5-7): God refuses his offering, but urges him to offer up an acceptable one
 - 3. The assassin (Genesis 4:8-16)
 - A. Cain's crime (v 8): Kills Abel in a fit of rage and envy
 - B. Cain's curse (vv 9-12): A vagrant and wanderer
 - C. Cain's complaint (4:13-16): Afraid he would be killed, God marks Cain, and Cain marries
 - 4. The architect (Genesis 4:17-24)
 - A. Cain founded a society (vv 17-22): Builds the first city
 - B. Cain's descendants are the original herdsmen, tent dwellers, musicians, and metal workers
 - C. Cain's treacherous society practiced polygamy and were given over to violence (vv 23-24)
- III. Seth, the granted son (Genesis 4:25-26)
 - 1. Eve give birth to the third son
 - 2. God granted Seth to take the place of Abel
