“Preparation for the Flood,” (Genesis 6:1-22)

I. God’s Grief (Genesis 6:1-7): God sees nothing but human wickedness of every kind, everywhere, at all times.

1. What caused the world to become so wicked from creation to the flood? First, it was the mixing of Cain and Seth’s bloodlines (Genesis 6:1-4). Second, integration caused the worldview (mindset) of the people to change from theocracy (God led), to one that allowed them to live as they desired.
2. God decides to destroy humanity because of the total wickedness of humanity; the world was full of sin. Let’s read verses 5 and 6.

II. God’s Grace (Genesis 6:8-10): Noah, because of his faithful living, finds favor with God. We see three things in Noah’s life that God was pleased with in verse 9:

1. Noah was **just**, he did what was right and fair.
2. Noah was **perfect**, he lived right before the people.
3. Noah **walked with God**, he obeyed and lived before God.

III. God’s Guidance (Genesis 6:11-22): God tells Noah two things...

1. Destruction (Genesis 6:11-13): First, bring the flood and destroy.
2. Instructions (Genesis 6:14-22): Second, gives Noah instructions for building the Ark, to save Noah, his family, and all animals.
