GENESIS OUTLINE 7

"After the Great Flood," (Genesis 8-10:32)

Torrential rain fell from heaven for 40 days, covering the highest mountains and drowning all human life and animal life. Now the prophetic pattern is set. And one can follow this pattern as it runs from Genesis to Revelation. God did exactly what He said He would do.

I. Noah's Security (Genesis 8:1-5): "But God remembered Noah."

- 1. God does not forget, He simply guided, protected and made provisions for Noah and his family.
- 2. Noah's search (Genesis 8:6-12): The first attempt was with a raven, but unsuccessful (Genesis 8:6-7). The second attempt was with the dove, and successful (Genesis 8:8-12).
- 3. Noah's survey (Genesis 8:13-14): He removes cover of the Ark and takes a close look at the new world after the flood.
- 4. Noah offers up a sacrifice (Genesis 8:20-22): God accepts.
- 5. God give us signs (Genesis 9:1-17): Meat can be eaten, but not the blood. "Seedtime and Harvest (Genesis 8:21-22). Animals will fear people (Genesis 9:4). The rainbow (Genesis 9:11-17). The Noahic Covenant (Genesis 9:1-17): God restates our duties in human government (civil law).
