“The Tower of Babel and the Hebrew Patriarchs”

Let’s start tonight’s study by reviewing what God has previously commanded the people to do in Genesis Chapter 9 verse 1. The people would ignore God’s instructions and do what they wanted to do. This pattern has continued until today, and more than likely will continue until the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- I. **The sin (Genesis 11:1-4): All human beings attempt to unify themselves for their own glory. The leader was a man named Nimrod.**
  - A. God stops the construction (Genesis 11:6): God will only tolerate sin for so long, and then He intervenes. The punishment may vary but He will intervene.
  - B. Their punishment (Genesis 11:7-9): God scatters them by confusing their language at the Tower of Babel.
- II. **Introducing the Patriarchs (Genesis 11:12-50): The children of Israel recognized only three of the patriots, but we include Joseph because he plays such a key role in God’s plan.**

  - C. Jacob
  - D. Joseph
