"TAKING SERIOUSLY WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS" (PART 3)

(A View Point to Adopt)

LESSON: GOD'S WORD IS ALIVE, Hebrews 4:12, John 1:1-2, Romans 8:26

"The word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates, even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart". Hebrews 4:12

<u>SPECIAL NOTE</u>: We are not left alone in this world without hope! The Holy Spirit (HIMSELF) intercedes for us through <u>"indescribable wordless groans</u>". (Romans 8:26). SELAH!

Genesis 19:12-29 (NKJV)

Seriously, "warfare always surrounds the birth of a miracle"

INTRODUCTION:

1. WE LIVE IN A FALLEN, BROKEN, WORLD-IT IS NOT OUR PERMANENT HOME.

- a. We are trapped between: "our present sufferings" and the future "glory that will be revealed in us" (*Hebrews 13:14; Philippians 3:20, Romans 8:18*).
- b. Our (believers) weaknesses are ever before us (Matthew 26:41).
- c. We (believers) have very powerful enemies everywhere (Ephesians 6:11-13).
- d. We have been given the *"Ministry of the Holy Spirit"* (3rd PERSON of the *Trinity*) who has divine intellect, infinite wisdom, and vision. He has ability and power to pray effectively on our behalf, according to <u>the will and purpose of God</u> (1 Corinthians 14:15; Ephesians 6:18-20; Jude 1:20).
- e. The Holy Spirit comes along to help us in prayer, interceding for us (*this ought not to be confused with "speaking in tongues*"-<u>Acts 2:4-47</u>, <u>19:6</u>; <u>1 Corinthians 14:13</u>).
 Note: <u>Romans 8:26</u>.
- 2. GOD'S WORD IS ALIVE (Hebrews 4:12; John 1:1-2; Romans 8:26).
 - a. SHARP.
 - b. PENETRATES.
 - c. DIVIDES.
 - d. JUDGES.
 - e. INTERCEDES.

3. HEED GOD'S WISDOM (WORD) (Proverbs 1:1-6, Genesis 19:12-29, James 3:13-18).

- a. God equips us with (Divine) Wisdom- It is a Holy Spirit resource.
- b. Remember Lot and his wife. They also lived in a culture of foolishness.
- c. We must understand that there is <u>a wisdom that comes from this world</u>, and <u>a</u> wisdom that comes from God.
- d. The world's wisdom always <u>CONTRADICTS</u> the <u>DIVINELY REVEALED</u> Bible wisdom, on many important topics.
- e. Solomon, very concerned, urges us to know that there is a *reward* of "discernment (perceive)", to understand instructions and wise counsel.
