“The Veil of Moses” (Exodus 34:29-35)

After the Tablets of Stone (The Ten Commandments) were destroyed by Moses at the foot of the mountain, because of the rebellion of the people in making the Golden Calf, Moses went up again to the mountain to seek the will of God. The passage before us deals with what happened after Moses’ experience with God on that mountain.

“When Moses came down...” The previous verses reveal that Moses had no food or water during the forty days and nights, this being the second such fast that Moses had endured. Similar fasts were made by Elijah (I Kings 19:8), and by our Lord (Matthew 4:2).

- I. **Moses was seeking God on the mountain**
 - A. He went to God, he went...
 - B. He opened his mind and heart to God’s will

- II. **Moses experiences God on the mountain**
 - A. He experienced God in a miraculous way
 - B. He lost the stone tablets, but God replaced them

- III. **Moses received from God on the mountain**
 - A. New stone tablets
 - B. A renewal of the Covenant
 - C. A shining radiant face, the reflection of God

****Exodus 32-34 teaches four powerful lessons:**

- (1) Sin separates from God
- (2) No one is ever so far from sin that he can relax his guard
- (3) Any success achieved that forfeits the presence and blessing of God is worthless
- (4) Other people will be able to see it (God’s reflection) when one maintains close fellowship with God
