

Campus Safety: Awareness and Prevention Initiatives

The Utah College of Dental Hygiene, a division of Careers Unlimited, LLC (UCDH) is committed to providing a safe and secure environment to its campus community. Each year, UCDH publishes a Campus Security Program that provides detailed information regarding a variety of safety and security topics, including the College's Drug-Free Environment and Sexual Misconduct Policies.

In efforts to provide awareness and information regarding these important topics, the following highlights a few safety awareness initiatives:

- The Campus Security Program is distributed in an annual e-mail notification by October 1st of each year.
- All staff are required to sign a Policy Notification acknowledging the receipt of College policies, including campus safety information.
- New students receive an overview of campus safety information during New Student Orientation.
- Continuing students will re-review the information during Second-Year Orientation. The information is presented by the College's current Title IX Coordinator and students are asked to sign an acknowledgement following the presentation of information.
- Other materials used to raise awareness include the use of interactive quizzes. The program allows students to complete a quiz on a variety of topics related to Drug, Alcohol, Sexual Misconduct awareness and prevention. The program is interactive and allows students to join the quiz on their phones or laptops and then provides a graph of the responses.
